Eight Hundredand Two DOLLARS,the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County ofTulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot (2) two in Block (2) two of Oak Grove Addition to the City of Tulsa according to the recorded plat thereof, with the recorder of Deeds for Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

Gillespie and Maude Gillespie, his wife for their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents the same lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever, except taxes accrued,and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part their heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same. The grantor covenants that no dwelling house shall be constructed within fifteen years on said premises to cost less than \$2000.00 and further that said premises shall never be sold to anyone.
