WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One thousand, sixty-one

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of
the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

All of the east half southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section two (2) township
19, range 13 east, lying north of the N.W. of sec. 7. Right of way, except the

of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section two
township 19 north, range 13 east, less the north 68 feet thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
