between D.W. Crouch and Alice Crouch

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred
Fifty and ~~no~~ DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of
the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

all of the south one half (½) of lots number
seventy and eight (8) in block number
two (2), in the first Lindsay addition
to the town of Tulsa Oklahoma according
to the survey of J. G. Battin Survey of that of
April 19, 1901; a perpetual right is hereby
granted to erect and maintain a sewer
across the north one half (½) of lot number
eight (8) herein described connecting with
the city sewer in the shallot on the north boundary
to have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said D.W. Crouch and Alice Crouch
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second
part, that at the delivery of these presents they will lawfully seize in their own right of an absolute
and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises
with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,
charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, their heirs and
assigns, against said party of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to
claim the same.
