WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred and Fifty dollars \$1500.00 and the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
Lot one (1) and two (2) in Block forty (40) Lots twelve (12) in Block twenty one (21), Lot fourteen (14) in Block twenty four (24), in the Owen addition to the City of Tulsa Oklahoma according to the amended plat thereof doled April 25-1907 and duly filed for record -

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Party of the first part its successors and assigns for heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby warrant promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents it is lawfully seized in its own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, and to all and singular the above granted and described premises with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that it will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part its successors and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
