WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand and 700 DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
The most 14 feet of the south 54 feet of Lot 3 and the north half of Lots 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, & 10 in Block 32 in the town of Broken Arrow Oklahoma according to the official plat of said town

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

McKenna for themselves for their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
