This Indenture, Made this 11 day of November A. D. 1929
 between John Markham (a single man)
of Tulsa, Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and P. E. Reed
of Wagoner, Wagoner County, Oklahoma
of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
One dollar and other valuable considerations and DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of
 the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
 The northwest tenth and one-one-hundredth (0.01) acre of lot two(2)
 of section one(1) township twenty(20) row(10) N. range twelve(12) east
 less three acres for Skiatook Mission and less three acres for
 Cemetery, and less one acre for church, containing in all
 three and one-one-hundredth (301) acres, and being a part of
 the allotment of John Markham.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said John Markham,
 for himself, his heirs, executors or administrators, doth here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second
 part, that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in full own right of an absolute
 and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in, and to all and singular the above granted and described premises
 with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,
 charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that he will warrant and forever defend the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and
 assigns, against said party of the first part his heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to
 claim the same.
