The southeast quarter (SE¹) of the south west-quarter (SW¹) of north west-quarter (NW¹) of section twelve (12) township nineteen (19) north Range twelve 12 east

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Rachel Perryman
for herself, her executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 4 of the second
part, that at the delivery of these presents she is lawfully seized in her own right of an absolute
and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises
with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles,
charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;
