WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
One hundred fifty eight and noes DOLLARS,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of  
the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of  
Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:An undivided one fourth interest in the southeast quarter of southeast  
quarter of section four (4) and northwest quarter of the northeast  
quarter of the southwest quarter in section nine (9) and east half  
of northeast quarter of southeast quarter section nine (9) township twenty  
(20) north, range fourteen east, containing exactly (60) acres more or  
less.To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances  
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.And said Al G. Hickey and Maggie Hickey, his wife  
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second
