This Indenture. Made this 9<sup>th</sup> day of December A. D. 1909  
 between Pearl P. Gilliland and Hugh Gilliland, her husband  
 of Collinville, Tulsa, County in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and  
 Nathan O. Colburn, of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
 Seventeen Thousand Fifty and no/one and DOLLARS,  
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of  
 the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:  
 The west one half (½) of the southeast quarter (⅓) of section twelve (12) township  
 twenty two (22) north range thirteen (13) east, - containing eighty (80) acres  
 more or less, - as the same may be according to the United States  
 Government survey thereof, - subject to a certain real estate mortgage  
 dated November 24th, 1908 recorded in Book 50 page 317 of the records  
 of the Register of Deeds for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for the sum of  
 eight hundred (\$800.00) Dollars, made to C. H. Kishner.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances  
 thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Pearl P. Gilliland and Hugh Gilliland, her husband  
 for their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second  
 part, that at the delivery of these presents they lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute  
 and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises  
 with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,  
 charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; except that second  
 party agrees to pay taxes on the above described land for 1909.  
 And that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, his heirs and  
 assigns, against said parties of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to  
 claim the same.
