WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.)

whereof the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to wit:
 all of lots four (4), five (5), six (6), Block
 4 in the "T.T.T." addition to the
 City of Tulsa Oklahoma according to the
 recorded plat. Thereof, This deed is given
 by the grantors herein named to correct an
 error in a former deed made by them to the

 to the City of Tulsa Oklahoma, as aforesaid.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

 their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second
 part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute
 and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises
 with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,
 charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

 assigns, against said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to
 claim the same.
