WITNESSETH, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
 Thirty-seven Dollars and 00/100 and DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of
 Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section ten (10) in
 township nineteen (19) north, of range twelve (12) east of the Indian Meridian, except the right of way of the Arkansas Valley & Western
 Railway Company containing after exceptions 37 acres more or less.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Grant R. M. Gullough and Clara E. M. Gullough, his wife
 for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second
