hundred \$2400 and no DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
The west half of the south east quarter
of Section twenty-one (21) township nineteen (19)
north, Range sixteen (16) east, containing
80 acres, more or less according to the Surveyor's survey thereof

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.
