WITNESSETH, The said part I of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand  
and other valuable considerations and — DOLLARS,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part II of  
the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:  
Lot Thirteen in Block - Fifteen (15) in Street -  
Tulsa in said County and State aforesaid  
according to the recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances  
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said J P Bliss and Jessie E Bliss  
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part II of the second  
part, that at the delivery of these presents, that they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute  
and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises  
with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,  
charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part II of the second part, their heirs and  
assigns, against said part I of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to  
claim the same.
