This Indenture, Made this 20th day of November A. D. 1909
 between Frederick Knight Company, a corporation incorporated and doing business under
 the laws of the state of Oklahoma, as a law provided, in the office of the Register of Deeds
 of Tulsa County, in the state of Oklahoma, of the first part, and George L. Kirkendall
 of Tulsa County, and state of Oklahoma, of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Two hundred fifty and no DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, the heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
 Lot 10 and 11 in block 33, in said Knight, as appears by the Plat of the
 same on file in the office of the Register of Deeds, Tulsa County,
 Oklahoma. Said lots Knight's tract and plat in the 10th
 of the six quarters and the 10th quarter of the 10th quarter of section 39,
 township 41 North and range 3 East, of the Indian Land and
 Meridian.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Frederick Knight Company
 for the heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second
 part, that at the delivery of these presents the lawfully seized in the own right of an absolute
 and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises
 with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,
 charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that the will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, the heirs and
 assigns, against said party of the first part — their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to
 claim the same.
