WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

One Thousand and (000) DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The east one half of the northeast quarter of the northeast one quarter of section one (1) township eighteen (18) range thirteen (13) east, containing twenty (20) acres more or less, according to the Government survey thereof.

This deed is taken by order of Court, authorizing and directing Samuel B. Jones, Guardian, of Wilbur Jones a minor, to purchase from Flora Leaman the above described land, for the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) Dollars.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

for her heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents she is lawfully seized in her own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

save and except one certain oil and gas mining lease of even date herewith and that she will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part his heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part, her heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
