the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

the south half (1/2) of the southeast quarter (1/4) of the northeast quarter (1/4) of section 14, T. 22 S., R. 15 E., in township 22 north, range 15 east of the Indian

the north 1/2 of section 17, T. 22 N., R. 15 E., in township 22 north, range 15 east of the Indian Base and Meridian
