This Indenture, Made this 1st day of December A.D. 1927  
between W. J. Storl and Minnie Storl, his wifeTulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and  
Frank D. Lewis

of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

Three thousand five hundred (3,500.00) and DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to wit:

Part of lot, seven (7) blocks one hundred fifty two (152) described as all that part of said lot, seven (7) which adjoins lot six (6) and has a frontage of forty-five (45) feet on Boulder Avenue and extends to an ally at distance of one hundred forty (140) feet, with a uniform width of forty-five (45) feet, in the city of Tulsa Oklahoma, according to the government's plan and survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said W. J. Storl and Minnie Storl, his wife  
for their children, heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents Frank D. Lewis lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; except excepting in the sum of one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars to the State of Oklahoma Trust Company, which the party of the second part assumed and agreed to pay; and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
