WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, ~~etc.~~ heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances  
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Bill Denning and Mary Burroughs Denning his wife  
for ~~the~~ heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents 1929 lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute  
and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises  
with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,  
charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever, ~~except as to a~~  
~~certain specific date November 29, 1920~~  
and that ~~they~~ will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part ~~etc.~~ heirs and  
assigns, against said party of the first part ~~etc.~~ their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to  
claim the same.
