WITNESSETH, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two hundred fifty
5 (\$750.00) and DOLLARS,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, dated by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The southeast quarter of the southwest of section eleven (11) township sixteen (16) north range thirteen (13) east containing forty acres, more or less according to government survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said John S. Miller and Mary Miller and
 for their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents — they are lawfully seized in fee simple of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

except that to L. G. Clark
 and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part and their heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part — their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
