This Indenture, Made this 17 day of December A. D. 1909  
 between W. P. Moore and Anna E. Moore his wife

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eleven Thousand and  
 (\$11,000) and — DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of  
 the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:  
 (East half (½) of the south west quarter (1) and Lots  
 three (3) and four (4) of section seven (7) )  
 Township nineteen (19) north Range thirteen (13)  
 east of the north west quarter of the south  
 east quarter and the south west quarter of  
 the south east quarter (¼) of section seven (7)  
 and the north half (½) of the south west quarter  
 (¼) of Section Thirty three (33) Township nineteen  
 (19) north Range thirteen (13) east

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances  
 therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said W. P. Moore and Anna E. Moore his wife  
 for their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second  
 part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their right of an absolute

 with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,  
 charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, their heirs and  
 assigns, against said party of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to  
 claim the same.
