WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand ~~no~~, or \$3000 and DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
 all of Block Seven, including Lots from One(1) to ~~(1)~~ inclusive in Highlands Second Addition to the City of Tulsa in Tulsa County Oklahoma, according to a survey and plat thereof on file and of record in the office of Register of Deeds in said Tulsa County Oklahoma

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said F. C. Giddings for his heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever, except as to a certain gas lease dated Nov 19 - 1906 and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part his heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
