This Indenture, Made this 15th day of December A. D. 1929
 between John O. Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell husband
 and wife of Tulsa
 Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and L. E. Lewis of
 Tulsa Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma
 of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seven Thousand
 and Five Hundred and ⁷⁵/₁₀₀ DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of
 the second part, heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

a lot or parcel of ground out of the south mortuary, part of
 of lots 5 and 6 in Block 133 in the town of Tulsa
 being 70 ft x 150 ft more particularly described as follows—

Beginning at the south west corner of Block 133, thence
 in an easterly direction along the south line of Lot 5, 70 ft.
 thence at right angles in a northerly direction 150 feet thence
 in a westerly direction and at right angles a distance of 70 feet
 to the west line of Lot 6, thence in a southerly direction to
 west line of said lots 5 & 6 a distance of 150 feet to a place of
 beginning as said lots and are shown on the recorded plat
 thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said John O. Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell
 for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second
 part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute
 and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises
 with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,
 charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part and their heirs and
 assigns, against said parties of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to
 claim the same.
