This Indenture, made this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of October A.D. 1909  
 between J. M. Crutchfield and Nellie D. Crutchfield  
 his wife of  
 Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and  
 W. S. Arbutrurt<sup>o</sup> of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand  
 dollars (\$5000.00) and no DOLLARS,  
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of  
 the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of  
 Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots One (1) and Two (2) otherwise described  
 as the north half of the northeast quarter and the  
 south half of the north east quarter of Section two  
 (2) townships eighteen (18) north and range fourteen  
 (14) east of the Indian Base and meridian known  
 as the Green River allotment containing 160  
 acres more or less according to the Government  
 survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances  
 thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said J. M. Crutchfield and Nellie D. Crutchfield, his wife  
 for their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second  
 part, that at the delivery of these presents, they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute  
 and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises  
 with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,  
 charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part, his heirs and  
 assigns, against said part of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to  
 claim the same.
