between Harry G. Davis and Mabel L. Davis his wife

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and
per cent of five ^{hundred} 175⁰⁰ and ^{hundred} DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of
the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of
Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

the south east six acres of Lot four less one and seventy
hundredths acres 1.70 for midland Valley Right of way and
north west 4.17 acres of Lot four less 1 acre for midland
Valley Right of way and north 4.12 acres of south west 9.12
acres of Lot four less 1.58 acres for midland Valley
Right of way and south east 2.50 acres of south west
9.12 acres of Lot four less .39 acres for Midland Valley Right
of way all of Section ten (10) Township seventeen (17) more

claim the same, except as to taxes
