WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred
Fifty and 450⁰⁰ DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot five (5) of Block eight (8) in Highlands addition to Tulsa Okla according to the plat thereof filed and of record in the office of the Recorder in and for the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Edward R. Giddings and Nettie P. his wife for their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever, except as to a certain Gas Lease dated Nov 17 06 and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
