

This Indenture, Made this 10th day of January A.D. 1910
 between Mable F. Leonard and Murray B. Leonard,

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and
Marie U. Cengert of Hoganor, Okla
 of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said part II of the first part, in consideration of the sum ofOne hundred \$100.00 DOLLARS,the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part II of
 the second part, hers heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of
Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

In equal and undivided one-half interest in and to the following
 described land, so-wit: The southeast quarter of the
 southeast quarter and the southeast quarter of
 the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of
 section six (6) Township Twenty (20) north, range
 fourteen (14) east, containing 50 acres more or less.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Mable F. Leonard and Murray B. Leonard, his and her
 heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said part II of the second
 part, that at the delivery of these presents They are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute
 and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises
 with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,
 charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part II of the second part, heirs and
 assigns, against said part II of the first part and their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to
 claim the same.

 written.


