This Indenture, Made this 13<sup>th</sup> day of January 1910, between W.C. Baze and Bertha S. Baze, his wife

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and R. Arthur of Tulsa Tulsa County, Oklahoma of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and 100/100 DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

(1) Lot numbered Seven Block numbered Twenty-six (26) in Owen Addition to Tulsa according to the official plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said W.C. Baze and Bertha S. Baze his wife for their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former, grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever, except a mortgage for \$1000 to the Farming Home Loan Assoc of Ok and another for \$7500 to E.C. Hensuch and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part, their heirs and assigns, against said part of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
