DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 8th day of March, A. D. 1910, between

in the Urban Addition of the City of Tulsa Oklahoma
according to the amended plat thereof dated
April 25, 1907 and filed for record.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
 anywise appertaining, forever.

And said party of the first part
 for his heirs, executors or administrators, do as hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part y of the second part,
 that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible
 estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the
 same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances,
 of what nature and kind soever;

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part y of the second part 1/10 heirs and
 assigns, against said part y of the first part his heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
