DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 7th day of January, A. D. 1910, between Florence Collins, a single woman, Roll number 4969 of Collinville, Rogers County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and James L. Braden of Collinville, Oklahoma, of the second part:

WITNESSETH, The said part 4th of the first part, in consideration of the sum of two thousand Two hundred & ~~200~~²⁰⁰ (\$2200.00) DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 4th of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: Lot one 1/4 and Southwest quarter (S.W. 1/4) of Northeast quarter (N.E. 1/4) of Southeast quarter (S.E. 1/4) and East One-half (E. 1/2) of Northeast quarter (N.E. 1/4) of southeast quarter (S.E. 1/4) and Northwest (N.W. 1/4) quarters of Northeast quarter (N.E. 1/4) of Northeast quarter (S.E. 1/4) of section Two (2) Township twenty-one (21) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian. This deed is made subject to a deed of trust dated December 1st, 1907, recorded December 14th, 1907, at 2:05 o'clock P.M. in Book 27, page 13, of the records of the Register of Deeds for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, amount \$8,000.00 due December 14th, 1917, also Trust Deed dated December 1st, 1907, recorded December 14th, 1907, at 2:10 o'clock P.M. in Book 28, page 14, of the records of the office of Register of Deeds for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, amount \$16,000.00 also an oil and gas mining lease, dated March 10th, 1909, recorded March 23rd, 1909, in Book 53, page 130 of the records of the office of Register of Deeds for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, said lease executed by Florence Collins to G. L. Braden. Said Trust Deeds and lease are to be assumed by second part.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Florence Collins, a single woman, Roll number 4969, for her heirs, executors or administrators, doth hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 4th of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents, she was lawfully seized in her own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever, excepting as above set forth.

and that she will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part 4th of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against said part 4th of the first part, her heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
