DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 2nd day of February, A. D. 1912, between
Emil A. Mangold and Rose A. Mangold, husband and wife
of Tulsa
 Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and
A. C. D. Bullington, of Tulsa Oklahoma party
 of the second part:

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Eleven Thousand (\$11,000.00) and _____ DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot numbered One in Block numbered
One Hundred and Sixteen in the City of Tulsa Oklahoma
according to the Government plat thereof

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Emil A. Mangold and Rose A. Mangold for themselves and
 for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part,
 that at the delivery of these presents they lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible
 estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the
 same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances,
 of what nature and kind soever; except paving and sewer installments of or 1910
and subsequent years
 and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and
 assigns, against said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
