DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 25th day of October, A. D. 1929, between
Nora Marshall and D.P. Marshall her husband of Tulsa
 Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and J.P. Kiddings,

of the second part:

WITNESSETH, The said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum of (#650.00)
Six hundred Fifty and 00/100 DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 2^d of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The west (50) fifty feet of Lot B, three blocks (97) Ninety seven in the
incorporated city of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
 anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Nora Marshall and D.P. Marshall,
 for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 2^d of the second part,
 that at the delivery of these presents they lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible
 estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the
 same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances,
 of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part 2^d of the second part his heirs and
 assigns, against said part 1st of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
