DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 12th day of February, A. D. 1910, between
 Grace A. Folts, a widow, and Metta V. Abbott,
 and G. H. Abbott, her husband,

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and

J. E. Reddout

of the second part:

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
 One

and no DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
 her heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: The northerly Fifty (50) feet of the Five (5) in Block
one hundred Ninety six (196) in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,
 more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of said lot
 corner of said Lot Five (5) fence along the northerly line of said lot
 northeasterly one hundred forty (140) feet to the northeast corner of said
 lot hence along the easterly line and to southeastern Fifty (50) feet,
 thence at right angles and parallel with the northerly line of said
 lot southeasterly one hundred forty (140) feet to the west line of said

 that at the delivery of these presents, they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible
 estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the
 same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances,
 of what nature and kind soever; Except taxes general and special for the year 1910 and
 thereafter
 and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part and their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
