

DEED—GENERAL WARRANTY.

CONFIRMED

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 15th day of January, A. D. 1910, between
Bessie Holloway and W.C. Holloway her husband
 Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and C. A. Holloway
 of the second part:

WITNESSETH, The said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One dollar and
other good and valuable Considerations and DOLLARS
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 2^d of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: Lot No One (1) and the north half of Lot No.
Two (2) and lots numbered Four (4) Five (5) Six (6) Seven (7)
Eight (8) Nine (9) Ten (10) Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) in
Block No One (1) and lots numbered one (1) Two (2) Three (3)
Four (4) Five (5) and Six (6) in Block Three (3) all in the
Cody and Holloway Addition, to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma
according to the duly recorded plat of said Addition

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
 anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Bessie Holloway and W.C. Holloway her husband
themselves their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 2^d of the second part,
 that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible
 estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the
 same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances,
 of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part 2^d of the second part his heirs and
 assigns, against said part 1st of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
