 All of our undivided interest in and to the Northeast quarter (N.E. 1/4)

 east containing One Hundred and sixty acres (160) the same being  
 our undivided interest in and to the said land as being the heirs  
 at law of Isaac Tiger deceased. The grantor herein Jacob Tiger
