in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Kemp & Hayden, Co. partners composed of E. R. Kemp and John F. Hayden the following described real property and premises, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All her undivided right, title and interest in and to the Northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 32, and the west half (W 1/2) of the East half (E 1/2) of the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 29, all in Township 21 North, and Range 13 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 80 acres more or less, situated in said County and State, and being lands allotted to Rachel Rainerow, Cherokee, by Flood roll number 15724, deceased mother of said grantor, and whose death occurred on the 20th of April 1910.
