Meridian containing eighty acres more or less and  
being a part of the allotment of Robt M<sup>c</sup>Intosh  
deceased; Subject however to certain mortgages now ex-

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging, and warrant the title to the same.  
To have and to hold said described premises unto the said part y of the second part his heirs and assigns, for-
