WARRANTY DEED.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That S. H. Honey and Sarah M. Honey his wife of Tulsa County, Okla., parties

of the first part, in consideration of the sum of twenty five hundred DOLLARS,

(\$ 2500.00), in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Edw. Randall

the following-described real property and premises, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Commencing at the SE corner lot three (3) in Block one hundred and twenty three (123) in the town of (now City) of Tulsa Oklahoma, thence west along the south line of said lot 60 feet for a starting point, thence north 50 feet parallel to the east line of said lot, thence west 40 feet parallel to the south line of said lot, thence south 50 feet parallel to the east line of said lot, thence east 40 feet along the southline of said lot to starting point above mentioned.

Grantor assumes and agrees to pay one half of amount of principal and interest unpaid upon one certain mortgage now on said premises to Tulsa P. & L. Assoc. July of Record.

Also this conveyance is made subject to the paving, access and assessments now thereon. Grantor as part consideration thereof is given the right to connect with the sewer on the N. line of said premises and to use & maintain the same to the alley being the alley on the west side of said lot above described.

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging, and warrant the title to the same.

To have and to hold said described premises unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever; free, clear and discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes, judgments, mortgages and other liens and encumbrances of whatsoever nature.
