the following-described real property and premises, situate in County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

A tract of ground, 100 by 100 feet, lying in the reserved part of the additional to the town of Rockwood shall be situated and bounded as follows:

Converging at a point 139 feet west of Main street on the north line of L street hence north 140 feet thence east 100 feet thence south 140 feet thence west 100 feet to the place of beginning

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging, and warrant the title to the same.

To have and to hold said described premises unto the said part ~~of~~ ^{of} the second part ~~here~~ ^{here} heirs and assigns, forever; free, clear and discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes, judgments, mortgages and other liens and encumbrances of whatsoever nature.
