

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

 WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred and No. 100 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Collierville Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:

Lot Number Four (4), in Block number Seventy Three (73), in the incorporated town of Collierville, T. I., according to the government plat thereof.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Chris Brecken, wife of the said Frank Corbin, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
