GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 25th day of February, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between Nathan Jones, a single and unmarried person and Harry H. Lewis of Muskogee, part of the first part, and of Muskogee part of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:

North Half of the South East Quarter of the North West Quarter and the North Half of the North Half of the South Half of the South East Quarter of the North West Quarter and Lot three (3) and N North 26 08 acres of Section 15 (15) Township Eighteen (18) North and Range Twelve (12) East of the Indian and Meridian.

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, wife the said, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
