GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 28th day of February 1905, one thousand nine hundred and by and between George H. Insler and Emerette H. Insler of Broken Arrow, D. I., parties of the first part, and of Broken Arrow, D. I. part of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Okla. Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:

Lots number One (1), Two (2), Three (3), and Four (4) in Block Number Seventy-five (75) in the Town of Broken Arrow, Indian Territory.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Emerette H. Insler, wife of the said George H. Insler, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part, all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
