

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 16th day of March, one thousand nine hundred and seven by and between J. D. Shubert and Rosa L. Shubert of Broken Arrow, I.T., parties of the first part, and Lillie E. Kemp of Broken Arrow, I.T. party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand 77 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit: lots four and five in Block number fifty nine in the town of Broken Arrow, Indian Territory

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Rosa L. Shubert, wife of the said J. D. Shubert, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
