

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 16th day of February, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between J. A. Henry and Lou Henry, his wife of Red Fork, I.T., parties of the first part, and Bank of Red Fork (a corporation) of Red Fork, Ind. Ter. part of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of eleven hundred and thirty seven Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:

All of lot numbered Eleven (11) in Block Forty-six (46) in the town of Red Fork, Indian Territory, according to the record plat thereof

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Lou Henry, wife the said J. A. Henry, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part of the second part its heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
