

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 26 day of April, one thousand nine hundred and zero, by and between S. K. Williams and Bessie L. Williams of Muskogee, part us of the first part, and Joseph Mills of Adelma part y of the second part,
 WITNESSETH: That the said part y of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty fifty hundredths Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part y of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:
Lot seventeen (17) in Block four (4) in Valley

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Bessie L. Williams, wife of the said S. K. Williams, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part y of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part y of the second part heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
