WITNESSETH: That the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred fifty, 150/100 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Indiana Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:

All of Lot number seven (7) in block number thirty-six (36) in the town of Collinsville, Indian Territory, according to the approved Government plat of said town, together with all improvements thereon, this Lot being fifty feet in width.

Said party of the second part is to pay all appraisements that are now due or that will be due due to the Delaware Nation on said Lot.

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, wife the said

for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
