GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 10th day of April, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between E. J. Neibling and Cora Neibling, his wife of Broken Arrow, Ok. part 1st of the first part, and of Broken Arrow, Ind. part 2nd of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said part 1st of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Forty Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part 2nd of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit: lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 in Block 3, in the Homestead Addition to the town of Broken Arrow, Indian Territory,

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Cora Neibling, wife the said E. J. Neibling, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part 2nd of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part 2nd of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
