WITNESSETH That the said part 1 of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part 4 of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:

The south half (1/2) of the southwest quarter and the south west quarter of the south west quarter of the section twenty six (26) township eighteenth (18) north range fourteen (14) east containing one hundred and twenty (20) acres more or less.

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, [Signature], wife the said [Signature], for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part 4 of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part 4 of the second part heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
