

# GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 21<sup>st</sup> day of May, one thousand nine hundred and 09, by and between Lillie L. Marshall and Francis M. Marshall of Broken Arrow part 1<sup>st</sup> of the first part, and John W. Pennington and Anna A. Pennington of Broken Arrow part 2<sup>nd</sup> of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said parties of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Creed Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:

Lots eighteen (18), nineteen (19), twenty (20), twenty one (21), and twenty two (22) in Block thirty four (34), also the north twenty three (23) feet of lot eleven (11) in Block thirty four (34), all lying and being in the town of Broken Arrow Indian Territory

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Lillie F. Marshall, wife the said

Francis M. Marshall, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said parties of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said parties of the second part their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
