

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 23rd day of March, one thousand nine hundred and ninety by and between Rachel Bough and John Bough of Okmulgee, part ies of the first part, and Fred Baker of Broken Arrow, part y of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand 4 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part y of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Greek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit: The west half of the north-east quarter and the west most quarter of the north-east quarter of Section number in Okmulgee range fourteen west of the Indian Base and meridian in Indian Territory

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Rachel Bough, wife the said John Bough, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part y of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part y of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
