

# GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

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This Indenture, Made and entered into this 17 day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between Squire Silk and Emma Silk of Biggs, Ind. Ter., part y of the first part, and J. H. Childers & Chas. Olenine of Muskogee, Ind. Ter. partys of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said partys of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One & no/100 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said partys of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Cherokee Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit: 1/2 of SE 1/4 of Sec 24 and the NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec 8 Township 20 Range 13 and the NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec 36 Township 24 Range 24 containing 100 acres more or less the Alice Silk deceased allotment.

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, Emma Silk, wife of the said Squire Silk, for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said partys of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said partys of the second part heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
